Eligibility

With the exception of Fast Track Solutions, all projects must be completed between December 1, 2011, and December 1, 2013. Fast Track solution submissions are to be completed after December 1, 2013 and to have a duration of no longer than nine months.

The nominated project must be able to stand on its own. If the initiative is a phase of a larger project, only the benefits of the phase can be recognized.

Outsourced projects will be considered as long as they are managed and controlled by the state.

The project must be state focused (not regional, local or national).

Finalists will expand their outline during May into a full nomination for submitting to NASCIO.
